VINO ROSSO

Rosé Rubicone IGT – É Got

(Emilia Romagna) (100% Sangiovese)

Btl 19 | 175ml 5.5 | 250ml 7.5

Direct strawberry fruit, a rounded, harmonic taste with a clean dry finish, not hints of unpleasant sweetness. This is a proper rosé for proper drinking and is a great match with lighter pasta dishes and fish.

Pinot Nero IGT ‘Levigato’ – Colli del Soligo

(Veneto)

Btl 24 | 175ml 7 | 250ml 9.5

Ruby red in colour with garnet reflections. Fruity on the nose with notes of blackberries, cherries and raspberries with some spice and pepper. Full, very well balanced and intense on the palate. Pairs nicely with red meats and extremely well matched for those who enjoy red with their fish

Valpolicella Superiore DOC – Zenato

(Veneto)

Btl 27 | 175ml 8 | 250ml 10.5

The wine has a ruby red colour, a delicate bouquet reminiscent of cherries and wild berries. Medium to full-bodied and dry with a velvety finish.

‘Ripassa’ Valpolicella Ripasso DOC Superiore – Zenato

(Veneto)

Btl 38 | 175ml 11 | 250ml 15

Also referred to as baby Amarone. The deep ruby red colour of Ripassa, and the intense yet fine aromas come from the mixture of grapes. It is full bodied, harmonic, and velvety on the palate. A perfect match for pappardelle ragu and grilled meats

Merlot IGT Terre Siciliane (Glass Closure) – Cusumano

(Sicily)

Btl 22 | 175ml 6.5 | 250ml 8.5

Premium Merlot offering from selected vineyards in Presti e Pegni, Monreale. Lower yield vines offering higher quality fruit. An intense example of Sicilian Merlot. Soft and silky on the palate, with richly concentrated flavours of plums, wild berries and liquorice with notes of star anise, dried marjoram and mocha.

‘Il Medaglione’ Negroamaro IGT Salento – Leone di  
Castris

(Puglia) (Negroamaro & Malvasia Nera di Lecce)

Btl 24 | 175ml 7 | 250ml 9.5

80% Negroamaro and 20% Malvasia Nera blend. The wine is then matured in oak barrels for 4 months before bottling and release. Ruby red in colour with garnet reflections upon ageing. An intense yet delicate bouquet characterised with hints of plum and blackberry. Warm and velvety harmonic mouth feel. Oodles of rich, gutsy dark fruits.

Rubesco, Rosso di Torgiano DOC – Lungarotti

(Umbria) (Sangiovese, Colorino)

Btl 27 | 175ml 8 | 250ml 10.5

Aged one year in cask and one in bottle. A red with blackberry, dark chocolate and cherry aromas and flavours. Medium to full body, fine tannins and a flavourful finish. Pretty and balanced.

Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG Classico Riserva  
‘Caterina Zardini’ – Campagnola

(Veneto)

Btl 70 | 175ml 19 | 250ml 26

After fermentation, the wine is refined for 18 months in new French Allier oak barriques with a further 6 months in bottle. Bright medium- to full-bodied Amarone, balanced and creamy, with a subtle note of tarry smoke underscoring the crushed black cherry, dried fig and spice box flavours. Oers a zesty finish of moderate length.

Cabernet Franc 'Sugano' DOC Friuli Grave – San Simone

(Friuli – Venezia Giulia)

Btl 28 | 175ml 8 | 250ml 10.5

Deep, ruby red in colour with violet reflexes. Sugano has a typical grassy and mineral bouquet with notes of blackcurrant, blackberry, cherry and pepper. Full bodied in the mouth, good intensity, round tannins and a lingering after taste.

Costera Cannonau di Sardegna DOC – Argiolas

(Sardinia)

Btl 29 | 175ml 8.5 | 250ml 11.5

Named after the hillside vineyards, Costera is a deeply coloured, full bodied red wine. Typical notes of ripe strawberries, black cherries, herbs and spices abound. Warm and intense with the time in oak providing rounded tannins. Great length

Primitivo del Salento Piedalto – Perrini (Organic)

(Puglia)

Btl 26 | 175ml 8 | 250ml 10.5

Terrific bold, warm, southern Italian flavours, stewed plums and spice, but with a finesse and elegance that suits you and our food.

Chianti Classico DOCG – Poggio Bonelli

(Tuscany)

Btl 29 | 175ml 8.5 | 250ml 11.5

Deep ruby red colour and density. Clean, vinous sensations appear on the nose, sweetened by hints of spices and ripe fruit. Drinking beautifully now.

Montefalco Sagrantino DOCG – Lungarotti (Organic)

(Umbria) (Sagrantino)

Btl 49 | 175ml 13.5 | 250ml 13

Stainless steel fermentation with skin maceration for 28 days. Wood ageing for 12 months in barrique. Light filtering and 3 years in bottle before release. Plenty of dark plums, crème de cassis, chocolate, spices, liquorice and tobacco and cedar. Full body, very ripe and dense tannins. Lots of structure and a long finish. Intense but never overdone. This is a truly stunning wine.

Nero di Troia IGT – Cantina Feudi

(Puglia)

Btl 19 | 175ml 5.5 | 250ml 7.5

Dark dried cherries, mulled spices with a violet perfume emerging. Good primary fruit here too – black cherry, dark fresh plum. Medium body, with fresh and gentle acidity, ripe fruits and fairly dry and fresh tannins.

Tareni Syrah IGT Terre Siciliane – Pellegrino

(Sicily)

Btl 25 | 175ml 7 | 250ml 9.5

Lovely bouquet. Ripe brambly flavours, rich purple blackcurrant colours, mouth-filling and a heady spicy finish. A great example of Sicilian Syrah from this old and well established producer

Barbera d'Alba DOC – Serragrilli

(Piedmont)

Btl 29 | 175ml 8.5 | 250ml 11.5

Clear garnet red with a rich and intense nose with a good concentration of delicate, crisp fruity aromas. Warm and soft on the palate with a balanced acidity, leading to an elegant and clean finish

Mo', Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOP Riserva – Cantina Tollo

(Abruzzo)

Btl 29 | 175ml 8.5 | 250ml 11.5

A reserve Montepulciano d'Abruzzo with 3 Bicchieri accreditation (Gambero Rosso) Intense fruit aromas and notes of black cherry and forest fruits. Twenty-four months in oak casks and six months in the bottle for an ageing which improves with time. Deep ruby red with purple hues. On the nose a wide range of notes ranging from fruity blackberry, raspberry, Morello cherry and dried fig, to floral violet scents and hints of spices, liquorice, dark chocolate, clove, leather, coffee, balsamic mint. Full flavoured to taste with great length, complex and strong tannins.
